

## **Guernsey County Commissioners – April 9, 2026 Meeting Summary**

The Guernsey County Board of Commissioners convened in regular session on April 9, 2026, at the Guernsey County Administration Building.

During the meeting, the Board conducted the bid opening for the 2026 Chip Seal and Crack Seal road improvement projects. Bids for the chip seal portion were submitted by SC Construction & Materials in the amount of \$827,236.90 and Melway Paving at \$890,018.60. For the crack seal portion, Strawser Construction, Inc. submitted a bid of \$57,127.80, and Bituminous Pavement Systems submitted a bid of \$61,015.16. All bids were opened publicly and taken under advisement for further review.

The Board approved Resolution 26-101,

authorizing the Guernsey County Water Department to install a water tap at the Old Washington Fire Department. This action was approved in lieu of the County's customary \$2,000 annual contribution in recognition of services provided.

Commissioners also issued proclamations recognizing April 2026 as Childhood Abuse Awareness Month, Fair Housing Month, and National County Government Month, reaffirming the County's commitment to community awareness and public service.

Additional business included the approval of minutes from the April 7, 2026 meeting, as well as the review and approval of March financial, budget, and receipt reports.
